

HEERF II and HEERF III

Under the terms of the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) and the America Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA), students who were enrolled at Goshen College during the fall 2021 semester have received a one-time payment to assist in dealing with hardships caused by the coronavirus pandemic. CRRSAA and ARPA provided money to colleges and universities for emergency student grants. The purpose of the grant is to help cover expenses related to the cost of attendance (i.e., food, housing and utilities, health insurance including mental health care, transportation, or child care) or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus.

Goshen College distributed CRRSAA and HEERF II & HEERF III funding in a way that prioritized students with the greatest demonstrated need and ensures that funds are distributed as widely as possible. The amounts for the students enrolled for Spring Semester 2021 range from \$430 to \$866 per student and were distributed on February 19 and February 26, 2021. The amounts for students enrolled for Fall Semester 2021 range from \$1,0459 to \$ 2,096 per student and were distributed on October 10, October 14, 2021 and November 1, 2021. **Eligible students were not required to complete an application or file any other documents.**

Eligible students:

1. Full and part-time main campus students who were enrolled in Goshen College's traditional seated classes for the Spring 2021 semester (spring disbursement only) or Fall 2021 semester (fall disbursement only).
2. Filed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the 2020-21 (spring disbursement only) or 2021-22 (fall disbursement only) academic year or completed the Goshen College International Financial Aid Application.
